Dr. Kenny H. Chan, an internationally recognized pediatric otolaryngologist, is currently Professor in the Department of Otolaryngology- Head and Neck Surgery at the University of Colorado School of Medicine. He also serves as Chairman of the Department of Pediatric Otolaryngology at the Children's Hospital of Colorado in Denver. Dr. Chan served as President of the American Society of Pediatric Otolaryngology 2015-2016. Dr. Chan completed his residency in Otolaryngology- Head and Neck Surgery at Loma Linda University Medical Center. His pediatric otolaryngology fellowship was accomplished at the University of Pittsburgh Medical Center and Children's Hospital of Pittsburgh. Dr. Chan's career has been influenced in large part by his mentor, a true giant in the field of pediatric otolaryngology, the late Dr. Sylvan Stool. In addition, Dr. Chan received the Triological Society Presidential citation in 2010. He was further honored as Professor of the Year by the University of Colorado Department of Otolaryngology- Head and Neck Surgery in 2008.

The UCI Resident Graduation CME course this year will focus on **Contemporary Pediatric Otolaryngology**. The program consists of two days of lectures and interactive panel discussions focused on up-to-date management of common problems in children encountered by otolaryngologists. A special focus will be devoted to the multidisciplinary treatment and management of pediatric sleep disordered breathing and obstructive sleep apnea.

As part of the resident and fellow graduation, a research forum will be held Friday morning. Beginning in the afternoon, the Dr. Jack E. Sinder Memorial Lecture will be delivered by Dr. Kenny Chan, Professor and Chairman of the Department of Pediatric Otolaryngology at Children's Hospital of Colorado. In addition to delivering the Sinder Lecture, Dr. Chan will participate in several panel discussions throughout the course and share his wealth of experience in the management of complex diseases in pediatric otolaryngology.

The course will be held in the auditorium in Building 53 at UC Irvine Medical Center, located at 101 The City Drive South, Orange, CA. Parking is available in the patient parking structure (off Dawn Way) or by valet (both at an additional cost). UC Irvine Medical Center is centrally located near the junction of the I-5, CA-22, and CA-57 freeways, two miles from Disneyland Resort, 15 minutes from John Wayne Orange County Airport (SNA), and 20 minutes from the beach. We have arranged a limited number of hotel rooms at a special rate at the DoubleTree by Hilton (714-634-4500) hotel adjacent to the medical center and at the Hyatt Regency, Newport Beach (949-729-1234) on the coast, and a 15-20 minute drive away. Interested parties should contact the respective hotels.

The weather is pristine in June in Southern California, and the beaches are sure to be stunning. The Los Angeles Angels of Anaheim will be playing the Kansas City Royals at Anaheim Stadium (walking distance from UCI Medical Center).
